

PERFORM IN THE FANTASIAPERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES AT EQUINE AFFAIRE

We are seeking industry professionals to perform equine related acts that meet the current interests and needs of horse enthusiasts of all breeds and disciplines for the Fantasia productions. The opportunity to participate as a performer in Fantasia offers many advantages. Consider the following . . .

PERFORMER ADVANTAGES

- Performing directly to large audiences of enthusiastic horse owners attracts attention to your discipline, service, breed, or business affording you the distinct advantage of increasing traffic flow to your exhibit booth, Web site, and business contacts.
- All performers and their acts are listed in the Fantasia program distributed before and during act, featured on the Equine Affaire Web site, and properly acknowledged when introduced before each of his/her acts.
- All performers are immediately recognized as experts in their fields by virtue of the fact that they are being featured as performers in Fantasia. Being a performer may establish greater respect and credibility within the horse industry and possibly lead to an invitation to perform at other equine expositions.

POTENTIAL ACTS

The basic requirements for all performances are simple:

- The performance must be interesting, specific, and unique.
- The performance must be well thought out and fully developed with an emphasis on highlighting the horse(s).
- The performance must be choreographed to music.
- The performance must be entertaining in nature; it is not to serve as an endorsement or advertisement for any product or service.
- The performance title must be creative and interesting.

PERFORMERS QUALIFICATIONS

Performers featured in Fantasia must be:

- Qualified to ride in their discipline specified and must be able to provide his/her credentials.
- Comfortable performing before a large audience and an entertainer by nature, prior experience performing at other major horse expos is preferred.
- Able to provide a professional, polished presentation that is suitable for all members of a "family" audience.
- Available to finalize necessary details.

APPLICATION PROCESS

If you are interested in sharing your performance at an upcoming Equine Affaire please complete the attached Performer Application and return it along with a video of your act (in its entirety), choreographed to music. Performances are selected on the basis of their quality, relevance, uniqueness, and how they fit into the overall program being developed for each Fantasia production. A member of the Fantasia production team will contact applicants regarding their participation in an event. While we are not able to feature everyone who wishes to perform at each Equine Affaire, we do retain the names of potential performers in a database for consideration for future Fantasia's.

It is important to note that Equine Affaire Fantasia programs are finalized **six to nine** months prior to the show date. Time limitations, discipline repetition, and quality of performance are major considerations in performer selection.
