Dear Vendor,

All Ohio vendors are required to comply with all Ohio sales and use tax laws. One requirement is that a vendor be properly licensed. Before making retail sales or accepting orders in Ohio you must obtain either a county vendor's license or a transient vendor's license.

Once you have obtained a vendor's license, you must comply with the following:

- 1. Display the vendor's license or a copy in plain view at every place of business.
- 2. Charge the sales tax rate for the county in which a sale is made. Sales tax rates vary from county to county in Ohio and are available on the Ohio Department of Taxation's website at https://thefinder.tax.ohio.gov/StreamlineSalesTaxWeb/Default.aspx.
- 3. File sales tax returns and remit the taxes collected to the Department of Taxation. If the sales tax collected exceeds \$200 per month, returns must be filed monthly. Otherwise, returns must be filed semi-annually. Vendors must file sales tax returns regularly, even if no sales were made during the reporting period. Failure to timely file a return and remit the tax due may subject the vendor to penalties and interest charges.
- 4. All sales tax returns are required to be filed electronically. Electronic filing and payment may be accomplished through two methods:
 - Ohio Business Gateway (OBG): Once you have established an account with OBG you may file and pay your sales tax returns online.
 - Telefile: If your account is a county vendor's license (license number begins with 01 – 88) you may file via Telefile. Have your return completed and your checking account number and routing number available. Call 1-800-697-0440 to file and pay the return.

If you make retail sales in Ohio and do not currently have a vendor's license, you may obtain a vendor's license by completing the application on the back of this letter and submitting it, along with a check for \$25, to the Department, or online through the Ohio Business Gateway at business.ohio.gov.
