

Breed Pavilion Horse Rotation Protocol & Schedule

Each horse must be escorted by three people: one at the head, one at the tail, and one walking in advance of the horse.

The first horse to be showcased in your exhibit stall should be moved into the stall by 8:45am in the morning.

All horses will be moved into and out of the Breed Pavilion by aisle numbers. The Breed Pavilion layout included in the move-in and welcome materials shows the aisle numbers and the order in which aisles will be released. This document will also be posted at the horse entrance to the Stroh Building.

If your organization will be taking a horse out of your exhibit stall during a rotation time slot, you are expected to have the horse ready to depart your stall at the beginning of that time slot.

Equine Affaire will have staff at key locations within the Breed Pavilion to assist during each horse rotation. The horse owner should wait for Equine Affaire's staff to authorize him/her to lead the horse out of the stall and building.

After all horses have exited, horses will be allowed to enter the Breed Pavilion according to their aisles. This will happen about 15 minutes in to the 30-minute time slot. No horses will be allowed to enter until all have exited for each time slot.

Whoever is bringing a horse into the Breed Pavilion during a rotation should be prepared to bring your horse into the building about halfway through the horse rotation time slot.
