

Ohio Fire Prevention Regulations

A representative from the Fire Marshal's Office will be on the grounds during the Event to inspect areas of concern. If you have any questions regarding fire regulations, contact: *State Fire Marshal's Office (614) 752-8200—Code Enforcement Department*

1. All decorative materials, including (but not limited to) curtains, draperies, hangings, table coverings, and waste receptacles, shall be either noncombustible or flame-resistant. Fabrics such as burlap, fish netting, etc. should not be used unless pre-approved.
2. Combustible materials such as hay, straw, shavings, corn stalks, bark mulch, flammable liquids and gases are prohibited.
3. When permitted, trees and vegetation shall be live, balled, and kept watered. Pre-approval is required.
4. Tents, umbrellas, tarps, roofs, or any other type of "cover" in your exhibit space or as part of your display is strictly prohibited.
5. Any electrical light bulbs included within a display should not be decorated with paper or other combustible material unless flame resistant.
6. Multi-plug cube adapters, unfused plug strips, open junction boxes, and open wire splices are prohibited.
7. Extension Cords may not be affixed to any structures. They should not pass under doors or floor coverings, and they should be protected from environmental damage and physical impact.
8. Designated fire lanes must be maintained free of obstructions and vehicles at all times.
9. "No Smoking" signs should not be obstructed in any way, nor should they be removed. It is illegal to smoke in any area designated "No Smoking" by signage.
10. Unvented, fuel-fired heating equipment is prohibited.
11. Open flames (including candles), combustible goods, and storage or exhibition of fireworks are prohibited.
12. All Aisles and exits shall remain free and clear at all times.
13. Signs labeling exit doors and passageways should not be covered in any manner. No signs, decorations or products shall be attached to any part of a sprinkler system.
14. All fire extinguishers shall be accessible at all times.
15. No propane tanks are allowed in any display in any building of an Equine Affaire venue.
