VOLUNTEER TASKS

The following is a list of some of the positions that we will be filling with volunteers at the event. Please indicate the tasks you believe you would be best suited to fill and indicate the order of your preference by writing in "1" for your first choice, "2" for your second choice, "3" for third choice, etc. We cannot guarantee that you will be assigned to any job in particular, but we try to assign volunteers based on their preferences and abilities. Please note that to assist as a volunteer, you must be available to volunteer at least two shifts (a total of four hours) during the event, which includes set up and tear down days.

Set up of the event on Tuesday/Wednesday:	
Set up may include standing, walking, and stretching for a full shift, as well as frequent lifting and bending. Some lifting may be considered heavy. Jobs may include: hanging banners, putting up static clings on doors, setting out shopping bags, folding t-shirts/apparel at the Affaire-Wear booth, assisting in setting up and cleaning vinyl fencing for clinic/demo rings, taping down roofing paper for walkways in the Breed Pavilion, and moving equipment and supplies around the site.	
During the event (Thursday through Sunday):	
Distributing free event programs on foot at entrance gates	
Assisting with securing doors in buildings or entrances to parking lots	
Assisting with set up of round pens, jumps, and other clinic equipment	
Cleaning stalls after they are vacated (FRI & SAT from 8-12 ONLY)	
Assisting with horse rotations in the Breed Pavilion	
Assisting with youth-related activities in the Equine Fundamentals Forum

I understand volunteer shifts are each two hours in length and that in exchange for volunt shifts I will receive admission to Equine Affaire on two days.
